Enhancement of lifelong learning culture and mechanisms for university-industry cooperation via 3 special schemes for students, working adults, and research cooperation.

EXPLOITATION

Rollout of the philosophy and methodology of the GADGET pilot action to at least 100 European institutions. Bridging exercise for university-industry via café and newsletter.

GADGET aims to bring together the worlds of education and industry in the fields of environment and energy, creating mechanisms and good practice for cooperative ventures.
